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✓ What is the goal of the Career-Tech Early College Academy?

The goal of **MHS Career Tech Early College High School** is to utilize the fundamental approach of empowering teachers, inspiring students, and advance studies in business, criminal justice, teaching, precision manufacturing and welding technology. Throughout their four years of high school, students will be provided advanced educational opportunities focused in these five fields of study. Students may graduate from high school earning a Certificate, an Associate Degree, and/or up to 60 college credit hours.

✓ How is MHS Career Tech Early College High School different from the comprehensive high schools?

MHS Career Tech Early College High School is a school within the comprehensive high school which began in 2014-2015 with incoming high school freshmen; students begin a four-year pathway in the field of business management, criminal justice, teaching, precision manufacturing or welding technology which will promote college readiness through an academic design plan to prepare for success in higher education as well as careers in a global economy. Highly qualified staff will foster supportive relationships with students while challenging students in rigorous curriculum to acquire the necessary skills needed to be prepared for college, careers, and life. Students may take pre-AP and AP courses as well as dual credit courses, so they graduate with an endorsement in the area of Business and Industry and earn a Certificate, an Associate Degree and/or up to 60 college credit hours.

✓ How are students selected?

Incoming freshmen are selected based on:

- Willingness to take challenging and rigorous college level courses
- Interest in pursuing college and career programs of study in welding, precision manufacturing, criminal justice, teaching, and business.

✓ Students zone to MCISD's Veterans Memorial High School:

If accepted into MHS's CT ECA, students will have to complete *transfer documents* to enroll at Mission High School prior to the start of the school year. Documents are available at MCISD's Central Office. (956) 323-5500. Please state *Career Tech Early College* as the reason for the request.

✓ Expectations of a Career Tech Early College student:

- Assignments / Homework / Projects will be completed in a timely manner.
- Students will attend tutorials as needed or determined by STC and/or ECHS staff.
- ECHS students will be considered college students and held to the same standards as other STC students.
- Due to FERPA guidelines, students will be expected to relay information about their college courses with their parents/guardians.
- Effective Time Management, Study Skills, and Soft Skills will be practiced and implemented throughout the program.
